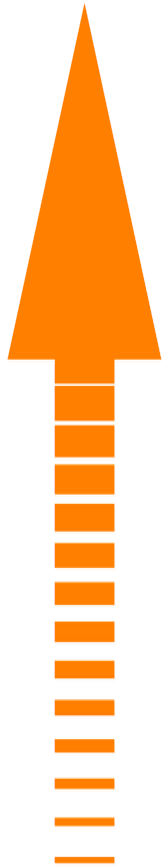


## Applying Bloom's Taxonomy to ToK PT#1 Nov 19

**2. Knowledge Claim: Validity / Accuracy of Knowledge is generally more important than Reliability of Knowledge.**

Level of thinking	Question(s)
<b>Creation<sup>1</sup></b>	Redesign an area of shared knowledge practice based upon the supremacy of individualism. Eg Film Censorship, Plane seat allocation, dieting recommendations etc
<b>Evaluation</b>	What are strengths and weaknesses of knowledge which is high in Validity in each of your chosen AoKs ?
<b>Synthesis</b>	Give examples of knowledge which is both reliable and valid from each of your AoKs. Is there knowledge which is neither reliable nor valid in each of your AoKs ?
<b>Analysis</b>	What are the features of Knowledge that is high in Reliability in each of your chosen AoKs ?  What are the features of Knowledge that is high in Validity in each of your chosen AoKs ?
<b>Application</b>	Give 2 examples of Knowledge that you deem to be high in <b>Reliability</b> in each of your chosen AoKs.  Give 2 examples of Knowledge that you deem to be high in <b>Validity</b> in each of your chosen AoKs.
<b>Comprehension &amp; Knowledge</b>	Choose 2 AoKs: How would you define Reliability and Validity in each AoK ?
