


Applying Bloom's Taxonomy to ToK PT #3 Nov 19.

3. Knowledge Claim: Confidence in Shared Knowledge is diminished because it is inherently unstable, and therefore inherently unreliable.

| | Level of thinking | Question(s) |
|--|---------------------------|--|
|  | Creation ¹ | Create criteria for identifying artistic (or scientific) knowledge which will be considered "classic" (or enduring) 100 years from today. |
| | Evaluation | Is there shared knowledge (from either chosen AoK) in which confidence has not declined over time ? Why did it not decline over time ? |
| | Synthesis | How might the Methodology of the construction of knowledge (in each of your AoKs) influence whether we have confidence in that knowledge ? |
| | Analysis | Does confidence in shared knowledge change according to context ? What different types of confidence in shared knowledge could exist ? |
| | Application | Give 2 examples of shared knowledge of which you are confident from each of your chosen AoKs. |
| | Comprehension & Knowledge | Choose 2 AoKs: What is meant by 'confidence in current shared knowledge' in each of your AoKs ? |
